THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD (C) 2 February 2025

Dear Parishioners

Today all Christian churches celebrate the Presentation of the Lord Jesus in the temple. This feast reminds us that forty days after his birth, Jesus is taken by his parents for the first time to the Father's house, to that temple to present him to the Lord – Offering the child to the Lord, as well as offering our life to the Lord, that is, handing it over to him, can be a source of great peace and serenity.

In this Mass known also as "Candlemas" we bless Candles to remind ourselves and recognise that Christ is indeed the "light of the world." We, also are called to be the light of the world and the salt of the earth, we can be the light of the world by the way we live our Christian life today.

THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Malachi 3:1-4, Hebrews 2:14-18, Luke 2:22-40

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - God had revealed to Simeon early on in his ministry that he would meet Jesus before he died. Simeon didn't know whether this revelation would come to pass and when this would happen. He continued to trust God wholeheartedly, stayed firm in his faith and was willing to be patient and wait for as long as God demanded. In psalm 40 the psalmist says "I waited patiently" and repeats the word waiting a few times giving it more emphasis. Waiting for God is a common thread in the psalms. In our faith journey and in times of prayer we are asked to wait however long it takes and not give up.


CATECHETICAL INSTITUTE


