THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18, Philippians 3:17-4:1, Luke 9:28b-36

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - Peter, James and John experience so many powerful emotions during and after the transfiguration of Jesus. At first they wonder what's happening, then recognise how special the experience is to see Moses and Elijah. Peter wants it to last. When a cloud obscures their view, they felt afraid and unsure again. What did they feel as they heard God's voice? And when the cloud lifts were they surprised to find Jesus on his own again? By the time they come down the mountain they don't speak of it to anyone.

It illustrates wonderfully the ups and downs, twists and surprising turns on our faith journey. It can be challenging to communicate to others the feelings of peace, wonder, confusion and elation we might experience in prayer, or in a moment of revelation or realisation. To share or not, and the timing, is a sensitive judgement.

As ever God's words are the best guide: "This is my son, my Chosen One; listen to him!" We have many opportunities this Lent to do that together in our parish community. MMcD

LENTEN JUBILEE YEAR THEMED REFLECTIONS: This Lent, Fr Habte and the parish RCIA team would like to invite all parishioners to take advantage of the Lenten reflections based on 5 themes of the Jubilee Year on Tuesday evenings at 8:00pm-9.00pm, followed by light refreshments in the lower hall. Our next evening for reflection will be on Tuesday 18 March, the theme is *Care for Creation*. All welcome.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS IN LENT - There will be Stations of the Cross and Eucharistic exposition and benediction on Fridays at 10:00am after the morning Mass during Lent.

"24 HOURS FOR THE LORD" This will be marked over two short periods on **Friday 28th & Saturday 29th March**. We start with 6pm Mass on Friday 28th March, and the church will remain open afterwards for quiet prayer and reflection with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Holy Hour on the theme of Jubilee, finishing with Night Prayer at 11pm. On Saturday 29th March, we have Morning Mass at 10.30am and the church will remain open until 12 noon with the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

LENTEN PENITENTIAL SERVICE will be on **Wednesday 9 April at 7.30pm** with visiting priests. We also have the weekly time of confession every Saturday morning from 11.00am to 12 noon.
