THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Isaiah 43:16-21, Philippians 3:8-14, John 8:1-11

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - The scribes and Pharisees are challenging Jesus' teaching about God's call for mercy and forgiveness. They hope to prove that he has no respect for the law of God which was given to them by Moses. They have not understood his teachings about judging others and the need for personal purity before daring to correct, let alone condemn, someone else. Jesus does not condone the sin of the adulterous woman, but he does confront the selfrighteousness of her accusers. They know their sins, even though they don't admit to them openly, and they are in awe of Jesus, even though they don't want to acknowledge that he comes from God. The oldest have had more time to gather a greater number of regrets, so they leave first, but eventually everyone can remember at least one sin and, perhaps, they suspect that Jesus knows about it, so they all go away. Then Jesus asks the woman, "Has no one condemned you?" "No one, Lord," she replies, realising that not one of her accusers was sinless. Jesus shows her the love and mercy of God, forgiving her with the admonishment that she should sin no more. PB
