PENTECOST SUNDAY (C) DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CHURCH ST WILLIAM OF YORK, BISHOP, FEAST DAY 8 June 2025

The Solemnity of Pentecost reminds us that the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Christ and is the divine Person who spreads in the world the possibility of imitating Christ, giving Christ to the world and making him live in us.

At Pentecost the church was born, when the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples of Jesus, and they received graces and gifts that made them fit to carry out the Great Commission. They needed the great advocate and comforter to live their calling and fulfil their mission.

The mission is what made them the special and help to create and grow the Church. It's what makes us the Church. We too are called for the same mission. A mission that must always be exercised with mercy and joy, which are the characteristics of Christ. We join our prayer with the apostles and all Christians who followed them, and pray "Come Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of your faithful!" Amen

THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Acts 2:1-11, Romans 8:8-17, John 14:15-16, 23b-26

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - Today's readings reflect the joy and happiness of the Apostles and Early Church at the coming of the Holy Spirit to the Apostles at a time when they were still in hiding for fear of being captured and executed by the Jews. Nobody could blame them for behaving in this way.

What follows is truly wonderful and inspirational for all of us. By receiving the Holy Spirit they were changed and fearlessly went out and preached the Gospel that Jesus had taught them to people of many nations in their own languages.

In our time the Sacrament of Confirmation gives us the Gift of the Holy Spirit to help us in our Faith Journey. The second reading emphasises and assures us of this.

Finally, let us remind ourselves that the Holy Spirit is there for us in our lives and will help us, if asked, to do what is right as followers of Jesus Christ.




