SAINTS PETER AND PAUL (C) 29 June 2025

THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Acts 12:1-11,2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18, Matthew 16:13-19

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - In our second reading, St Paul, at the end of his life, reflects on how God stood by him and enabled him to bring the Good News beyond the Jewish community to "the gentiles". Paul is confident that his God will be with him beyond death.

In contrast, our Gospel reading comes at the beginning of Peter's ministry, when he declares that Jesus is the Son of God. A shocking and courageous statement. Jesus gives Peter authority over the Kingdom of Heaven, telling him that what he binds or looses on earth will also be considered bound or loosed (released) in heaven.

Our readings about these founding leaders and teachers in our church, invite us to consider who Jesus is for us. How do we express or demonstrate our faith to others?

What harm would we like to limit forever? What would we like to forgive and set free forever? As we thank God today for these inspiring, deeply human saints, let's ask God to help us to see others generously. MMcD
