THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Amos 6:1a, 4-7, 1 Timothy 6:11-16, Luke 16:19-31

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - Jesus tells the parable of the rich man and the poor man who departed this life around the same time. The rich man had ignored the plight of the poor man at his gate while they were on this earth, but in eternity their situations were reversed. After suffering on this earth, the poor man was comforted, but the rich man, who had lived in comfort, was experiencing the pain felt by those whom he could have helped, had he but cared. Persisting in his self-centredness, the rich man asks first that the one whose poverty he had ignored be sent to soothe his pain and then that he be sent back to earth to warn his brothers: both requests are rejected. Jesus tells us that Moses and the prophets provide all the advice we need on how to find joy in eternity: God revealing Himself in the Old Testament. The parable ends with the assertion that, even if someone were to rise from the dead, those who indulge themselves, disregarding God's messengers, will not change their ways. Ultimately, this is fulfilled in Jesus' own death and resurrection: the New Testament, confirming God's generous love for every one of us, a stumbling block for the self-centred, but a firm foundation for those who seek to serve God, especially in caring for others. 
