THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Wisdom 9:13-18b, Philemon 9b-10, 12-17, Luke 14:25-33

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - In this challenging Gospel, Jesus is inviting us to be wholehearted about our faith; to love our God even more than we love the things and people that we hold closest to our heart. It's a call to follow the Gospel values of serving the common good, even when it costs us, or our relationships.

There isn't anything intrinsically good about the pain or exhaustion of carrying a cross. But Jesus asks us to carry our cross because prioritising someone else's needs is an act of love, and may mean that we miss out, are uncomfortable or tired. A greater love.

Jesus asks us to work at our faith so that we can be strong in testing times. We have daily opportunities to listen, give thanks, and love generously. Living our faith actively helps us to step up if the going gets tough, and to continue to choose faith, hope and love. Paradoxically our cross sometimes feels lighter when we focus on lifting other people up. But when our cross does feel heavy, we can draw strength from our faith and God's love.

The World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, celebrated on 1 September, is the official start of the Season of Creation, a time of sustained prayer and action which lasts a month and four days. During this season we are encouraged to pray and engage in community events in order to deepen our relationship with God, our neighbour and the earth we share, being ever more attentive to the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor.



The theme of Pope Leo XIV's message for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation is 'Seeds of Peace and Hope'. It was released on the Memorial of the First Martyrs of Holy Roman Church on 30 June 2025.

The tenth World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation will be celebrated on Monday, 1 September 2025.

This Jubilee Year also marks the tenth anniversary of Pope Francis's encyclical letter Laudato Si' that focuses on 'Care for our Common Home'.

Give us the grace to recognise, respect and protect all You have created, using wisely all that you have entrusted to us.


