TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C) 5 OCTOBER 2025

THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS - Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4, 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14 Luke 17:5-10

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - In this passage Jesus compares faith to a mustard seed and tells us that if our faith is strong enough anything is possible. I wonder how many of us actually believe this to be true! He then goes on to describe a situation where a master of a servant could invite him to share a meal instead of expecting to be served. We should be grateful for what people do for us whatever role that person has without taking into account how important or what status that role has. How often do we stereo type or take people for granted instead of showing them appreciation and respect? The final sentence says we are all merely servants. This maybe related to our work or our home life and will be at different levels. However, some of us only do the minimum expected of us instead of going the extra mile.

CATHOLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFERS - A new Diocesan Instruction is now in place whereby school forms will no longer need to be signed by the Parish Priest. All new school applications will only require a Certificate of Catholic Practice, signed by Fr Habte, which can be used for multiple schools.

In order to facilitate this process, please collect a yellow priest reference form from Fr Kenneth after Mass this weekend if you will be applying for your child to attend a Catholic secondary school this year. Please post the completed form through the presbytery letter box at 4 Brockley Park together with your contact details and copy Baptism certificate if your child was NOT baptised at St William of York by Sunday 18th October 2025. Fr Habte will contact you if he has any points to discuss and we will let you know in good time when your child's Certificate of Catholic Practice may be collected.

These walks are an opportunity to walk, talk and get to know your fellow parishioners and others in our local community whilst taking in some nature on your doorstep.



In particular, if you would like to bypass Blythe Hill, you can join either walk at the entry to Ladywell Fields on Ravensbourne Park from around 11.20 am.

Shorter route (2.8 miles) - St William of York > Blythe Hill Fields > Ladywell Fields > Cafe York

Longer Route (4 miles) - St William of York > Blythe Hill Fields > Ladywell Fields > River Pool Linear Park > Cafe York

Come prepared: Please wear suitable footwear for walking and layered clothing appropriate for the weather. Please come prepared for all weather, a bottle of water, a hat and sunscreen or an umbrella or hood. Please feel free to invite friends and family, all are welcome!




